Course Description:

Church Planting course approaches the subject from the following five reasons

To

1. Follow Biblical Strategy
2. Evangelize effectively
3. Gather in the harvest
4. Reach people groups
5. Fulfill the great commission

Course objectives

1. Introduce the students to the 12 foundational principles of church planting
2. Assist the students to be able to answer the question “why plant a church”. The student will also search their heart as to the proper motivation and concerns or fears that may present in planting a new church
3. Guide the students into an awareness that the Lord is the one who will lead, as one seeks to internalize the need and prayerfully seek God in every step and stage of the new church enable the student to develop a planned vision, plan, timeline as to the four phases of church planting for future use.
4. Help the student to be able to discuss the three-dimensional approach of the students own leadership approach and to write a personal plan for improvement
5. Enable the student to develop a planned VPT – Vision Plan Timeline on the four phases of church planting for future use.
6. Create an intentional process of discipleship and assist the student to have a discipleship program to grow converts into maturity in Jesus Christ thereby enabling them to minister their spiritual gifting’s
7. Cover the nineteen church planting landmines and so learn from the mistakes of others
8. Develop a culturally relevant outreach plan including church multiplication

Learning Outcomes:

By the completion of this course the student will be able to:

1. Identify the 12 foundational principles of church planting
2. Describe the nineteen church planting landmines and how to avoid them
3. Explain the three-dimensional approach of leadership by writing s personal plan for improvement
4. Discuss the reason for an intentional discipleship process
5. Illustrate from Scripture the reason as to why plant a church

Activities

The following activities address the differing sections of your workbook. Each activity will assist in compiling your response and understanding to the relevant subject in hand.

Activity 1

Develop a VPT – Vision Plan Timeline ready for presentation on the last day of training. Each VPT will need to be presented in a maximum of twenty minutes with another 10 minutes for questions, feedback and prayer.

This is not graded it is simply a pass

Activity 2

1. Prepare a preliminary church planting plan that includes one or more of the following:
 - A statement of your unique vision for this new church. Try to describe in concrete terms what this idealized picture looks like.
 - The church planting model you will use your philosophy of church planting. Your target group (Be specific!)
 - Your church name, logo, and slogan
 - Your “process of discipleship” which describes how you will help a curious seeker become a fully devoted follower of Jesus Christ
 - The number and type of staff your church will require Your evangelism strategy
 - The means you’ll pursue to financially support your family and the project
 - Your long-term plan for church planting reproduction
2. Create a first-draft Plan and TimeLine for at least one of the categories of ministry tasks listed in one of the four phases of church planting. Make your timeline cover one-year period, assuming a nine-month prenatal phase and three months of services after the birth of the church.

Activity 3

Phase one: Macedonia – God to you – the call

How can/did you receive a specific vision from God for your new church? How well formed is that vision now? Summarize the vision God has given you at the stage it is right now.

How will you communicate your vision to other?

Begin writing out your presentation to cast the vision to others to build a team to join you in this church planting venture.

Activity 6

Completion of a launch team commitment

Activity 7

Launch Team Recruitment:

Write out what kind of leaders you need on your launch team. Teachers, hospitality workers, worship leaders, children's workers, ushers, etc. Pray through potential people who might want to be a part of your launch team. Develop a plan for sharing your vision for the new church with them and a plan for developing them as leaders one they commit to being a part of your launch team.

Process of Discipleship:

Write out your process of discipleship. What process will you use to bring people into relationship with Jesus Christ and grow them into maturity. Describe the characteristics of mature Christian serving in the church with the vision God has given you. How will you develop your launch team spiritually with the process of discipleship

Consider and list the 5 most dangerous landmines to you and your church plant

Discuss and elaborate where you feel you are most vulnerable and what you will do to avoid these

Activity 9

Complete the exercise to develop your own VPT timeline

Activity 10

Develop your own Culturally Relevant Outreach Plan

Activity 11

Sketch your preliminary vision for your new church's first public worship celebration. Touch on issues like

- Facilities
- Greeting seating
- Music and worship – style
- Preaching and communication
- Follow up
- Overall length of service
- Childcare
- Children's ministries

Course Description:

Course Description

This course focuses on harnessing the power of the mother-daughter relationship and bringing new life to the church plant congregation through practical and proven principles of “daughter church planting,” that even a small church can make a huge impact for the kingdom of God.

Course Objectives

By the completion of this course, the student will be able to:

- i. Answer fears and objections to church planting.
- ii. Determine the involvement of the mother church.
- iii. Develop a timeline for the new church.
- iv. Find resources needed to fund the daughter church.
- v. Overcome common barriers in the new work.
- vi. Recruit a church planter and leadership.
- vii. Create personalised V.I.P. (Vision-Involvement-Plan).

Where do you find today’s lecture/material helpful, confusing, or frustrating?

What light does today’s lecture/material shed on your own experience, and vice versa?

Where do you feel yourself being challenged?

How does today’s lecture/material relate to you as a church-planter?

VIP—Using the CPC manual, develop a “**Vision, Involvement, Plan**” (**VIP**) and present it in class on the day specified by lecturers. For further guidelines, refer to your CPC training manual.
